



**As listed in public news, the FBI is reportedly quietly notifying financial institutions of a potential large scale hacking scheme that could hit ATM networks!**

### **Read on for your “To Do” List:**

In an effort to keep our members notified and up to date on the latest cybersecurity news, we would like to inform everyone of an article found in Tech-Insider regarding a potential large-scale fraud scheme known as an “ATM Cash-Out”. The FBI has notified financial institutions about this cybersecurity scam.

In this scam, hackers can attempt to use malware to access a financial institution or payment card processor and sometimes make fraudulent copies of cards by imprinting stolen card data on reusable magnetic strips.

These criminals will also try to remove fraud controls placed in the systems by financial institutions, such as maximum ATM withdrawal amounts and any limits on the number of member ATM transactions daily.

At Norristown Bell CU, we take these matters very seriously. We already have processes and procedures that carefully monitor your account safety. However, it is important that you manage your accounts regularly and immediately notify us if you see anything out of the ordinary on your account. Please contact us as soon as possible if you aren't sure about a transaction so one of our member service representatives can assist you. This will help us help you and all of our members!

In addition, please make sure you are financially prepared, especially as we come upon the Labor Day holiday weekend. If a national or international attack occurs, systems will need to be locked down and access via debit card from an ATM machine may be limited.
